ABOUT THE EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Spelman and Morehouse Colleges are two, historically black, liberal arts colleges located in Atlanta, GA. Spelman College, a women's college, and Morehouse College, a men's college, belong to the Atlanta University Consortium, Inc. (AUC). The AUC allows students to take classes at other member colleges, including students participating in the exchange program.

UC San Diego students may participate in the exchange program for fall quarter/semester, winter and spring quarters/spring semester, or one full academic year.

To be eligible to participate in the Exchange program, students must have a 2.7 UC GPA, and have completed a minimum of 66 quarter units by the time of application. Students must complete 90 quarter units prior to the start of the exchange quarter.

All registration, meals, housing and fees (if required) will be paid to the home institution. If you attend Morehouse College, you will be required to pay housing if there is not an equal exchange of students between the campuses. Students participating in the exchange program are responsible for their travel expenses to and from Atlanta, as well as any personal expenses.

In order to apply to the exchange program, you must complete:

- Exchange program application
- One-page statement of purpose:

 Please share why you would like to participate in the exchange program, and what you hope to gain through the experience.
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must come from a faculty member. (Please refer to the Reference Form)

When submitting your application, please be sure to schedule an interview appointment at the TMC Academic Advising front desk.
