TMC 198 COURSE DESCRIPTION

The purpose of the course is to (1) provide UCSD students with hands-on experience in urban schools, especially regarding the constraints on 6-12 students' learning in these settings and to (2) enable UCSD students to conduct basic research on issues of urban education, directed toward improving educational quality and preparing students for college. Classes are conducted as small seminars, allowing students to discuss their experiences on-site, critically analyze relevant topics in research and media, and learn from experts in the field through guest presentations and workshops.
