



## Choosing Your Significant Writing Course

Last updated: November 21, 2019

A course with significant writing is defined as “that writing activity in English which is performed outside of the classroom, judged by the instructor to be relevant and appropriate to the discipline and/or course content and requires the further development of expository and analytical skills and is an evidence-based argument.”

An approved course requires a minimum of 10 pages or two 5-page papers of writing, in which the writing (as well as the content) of these papers is evaluated. Midterm and Final Exams are not viewed as satisfying this requirement, even if they are take-home exams. We also require that the selected course be noncontiguous to the major. (See Disciplinary Breadth.)

Course numbers and content change annually. Each academic year, check the list of courses considered to have significant writing.
